FIELD ENTRANCE LETTER: Moved by Twombly and seconded by Wedemeyer to acknowledge receipt of the field entrance letter written by Engineer Kauffman to a landowner who did not request a permit and isn't meeting the requirements of the County's entrance policy. Approved.

ENGINEER: ROW Contract – Moved by Wedemeyer and seconded by Baier to sign the right-of-way contract with Ed and Gretchen Johnson for the N29 Prussia culvert for \$2,195.42. Approved. **Maintenance & Activities Report** – Engineer Kauffman gave an update to the Board on the following projects: Kauffman shared an email from a resident complimenting the secondary roads department on the ditch cleaning, 74.50/ton was the lowest bid for salt through the DOT, Murphy working Richland bridge deck tomorrow morning, Orient riprap today, ten hour days will start on Monday, W13 Jefferson letting will be on Monday, added more roads to the all systems permit, Schildberg's is done with half of the contract rock, Gus has N25 Grand River box done, and dust control discussion. Jotham Arber entered at 9:12 a.m. Kauffman exited at 9:16 a.m.

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH: Jotham Arber, Environmental Health, gave a quarterly update to the Board on the County's environmental health. They are back to doing perc tests and are about six weeks out on services. They will be sending Justin to become certified as a soil analyst. Developed a well book that outlines taking care of your well and are giving it to homeowners who are putting in a new well or just moving into a home with a well. They have 29 water tests scheduled which is the highest number they've had. They are finishing up the Beacon septic systems project. Arber will be coming back in June to discuss a new 28E agreement. Discussed DNR grants and timing.
