TAXABLE MEAL: Moved by Baier and seconded by Wedemeyer to approve the taxable meal for Twombly for \$11.76. Approved.

MANURE MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATES: Moved by Hoadley and seconded by Twombly to acknowledge receipt of the manure management plan updates for Van Eaton Site #1, Rectenbaugh Site #1, Thompson Pork, and Rectenbaugh Site #2. Approved.

GRAND RIVER TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE APPOINTMENT: Moved by Twombly and seconded by Baier to remove Skyler Rawlings as Grand River Township Trustee. Hoadley abstained. Approved. Moved by Wedemeyer and seconded by Twombly to appoint Paul Baier as Grand River Trustee. Baier and Hoadley abstain. Approved.

CROSSROADS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES: Brittany Palmer and Jess Petter, Crossroads Behavioral Services, request \$30,000 of the Opioid Remediation Funds for programming to youth in the community and local school districts for the 2023-2024 school year in Adair County. The funds requested cover professional training/time, curriculum, and materials needed to conduct the prevention programming. The poverty rate for Adair County is 10.2% and 22.8% of the county's population is under 18 years old. Mental Health data in 2021 in the state show half of students have had a suicide thought and have made a plan. Kids are six times more likely to engage when these programs are in the school. There is a Mental Health therapist that comes into NV's three buildings. This program is called "Too Good for Drugs" and would be 10 sessions with 7th graders on skills to resist peer pressure, how to say "no" and help students thrive. It also advocates for having a crisis plan and communication with the student, parents and staff throughout the HS years. Twombly suggested it would be nice to start programs like this in the elementary and Hoadley wished all High Schools in Iowa could afford a therapist along with a guidance counselor. Moved by Wedemeyer and seconded by Baier to pay \$30,000 to Crossroads out of the Opioid Remediation Fund. Approved. Palmer and Putter exited at 9:30 a.m.

REMINDER: Chair Walker stated that he wanted to remind Board members that when concerns are raised to a Board Member he/she need to follow the Chain of Command and go to Department Heads and not to the employees themselves.
