- 4. Over dimensional signs and flags must be displayed on all over dimensional loads over 75 feet long or over 8 feet 6 inches wide or over 14 feet 4 inches high.
- 5. May have a gross weight not to exceed 46,000 lbs. on a single tandem axle of the truck tractor and gross weight not to exceed 46,000 lbs. on a single tandem axle the trailer only. No single axle of the tandem group may exceed 24,000 lbs.
- 6. Prior to the move, call or email the Engineer's Office to determine if any roadway changes have occurred.

OVERWEIGHT REQUIREMENTS (OVER 80,000 lbs.):

- 1. Centerline all bridges. Roads with posted speeds under 55 mph centerline at 5 Mph. Posted speed limits of 55 mph centerline at posted speed.
- 2. Load must slow or stop when necessary to avoid approaching traffic when center lining.
- 3. Amber revolving light/strobe required on rear projection.
- 4. Amber revolving light/strobe light with 360-degree visibility required on towing unit for entire route.

LEGAL WEIGHT REQUIREMENTS (UNDER 80,000 lbs.):

- 1. 75' long x 12'5" wide x 14'6" high maximum dimensions for hauling hay, straw, or stover.
- 2. 120' long x 14'6" wide x 15'5" high movement restricted to 50-mile radius.
- 3. 120' long x 16' wide x 15'5" high trip routes must be obtained.
- 4. 120' long x 12'5" wide x 13'10" high unlimited distance no routing required

- Speed limit: maximum posted limits unless otherwise specified on permit.
- Road must be clear of ice and snow and visibility must be at least 1/4 mile.
- Hazardous materials must be transported in compliance with applicable federal regulations.
