RESOLUTION NO. <u>JOII-1/3</u> A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY CONCERNING THE CLEARING OF FENCE ROWS AND DITCHES

WHEREAS: The focus of the Secondary Roads Department must be on improving and maintaining the road surfaces, bridges, culverts and drainage on the entire road system.

AND WHEREAS: Clearing and shaping fence lines and ditches that do not make significant improvements to the road system is a waste of limited resources.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, That the Adair County Board of Supervisors adopts as policy that only those fence lines and ditches that, in the opinion of the County Engineer, have a decidedly adverse effect on roadside drainage, slope stability or public safety will be cleared or reshaped at county taxpayer expense.
