	The applicant agrees to give the County forty-eight (48) hours notice of its intention to start construction of the highway right-of-way.  Cable, pipe line and tile line crossing paved roads shall be constructed as follows: Pipe lines having and inside diameter of more than 2 inches which cross under the roadway shall be placed in casings so that the pipe may be removed for repair without disturbing the subgrade. The casing shall be of adequate strength, and of sufficient length to extend 2 feet beyond the edge of the surfaced roadway. On paved roads, cable casings may be placed through the subgrade by jacking, or by boring a hole just large enough to take the line: or if the County Engineer approves, a tunnel may be dug through, and the placed therein. On roads not paved, an open trench may be dug and the placed therein, and the trench backfilled over the line. All backfilling of tunnels and trenches shall be thoroughly compacted in layers of 6 inches or less in depth. Backfilling of trenches within the right-o-way shall be tamped sufficiently to avoid settlement. All work shall be done in a workmanlike manner, and the ground left in neat condition, satisfactory to the County Engineer in charge.
